# Advanced Housing Apprenticeship

**A Housing Apprenticeship can set you on a lifetime path to a professional career. It can give you the skills you need to progress in many branches of Housing provision.**

## What is an Apprenticeship?

An apprenticeship is the ideal way to earn money whilst gaining a nationally recognised qualification.

Apprenticeships are open to anyone aged between 16 and 24, although we do have opportunities for those 25 and above. Apprenticeships are available at Level II and Advanced Apprenticeships at Level III.

## How do I become an Apprentice?

You may be accepted if you are either: already fully employed in your chosen area and wish to pursue a nationally recognised qualification, or: are seeking employment in this area and have sufficient GCSE qualifications. Our Business Liaison Officers can help you and your employer access an apprenticeship programme or help you find a suitable employer.

## Where do I study?

You will study through flexible learning. This means you study partly at home with workbooks developed by CSHS, at work through your job and through a series of attended study blocks.

This blended method of learning allows you to manage your learning along with work and life demands at a time to suit you. You will have continual tutor support throughout your study. Assessment will take place through assignments, portfolio building and workplace reviews. CSHS will work closely with your employer to ensure that you have support in the workplace on a day to day basis.

## What will it cost?

You have to commit your time. Your employer has to commit to support you and assist with your learning. The financial cost of your learning is met through government funding.

## What will the Advanced Apprenticeship cover?

Three mandatory learning units based on Housing Foundations.

Additionally, you can choose five optional units from the following themes:

- Managing housing and assets
- Developing and involving individuals and communities
- Housing support services

Your key skills in communications and application of number will also develop.
